

Teacher Training

About this unit

The course is based on the British teacher education but the context is your own reality, the workplace in your own school. Your own workplace; school, classroom with pupils and your co-workers are important in your own learning process in order to get the acquired knowledge and skills to achieve a degree and qualified teacher status. We'll work with real issues, problems you meet and will tackle in the real life.

In this course we will not certify you for the qualified teacher status; it's a government body that certifies. In this program you will get grades based on your assignments and your work.

The teacher training will amongst many other things involve:

- A knowledge and understanding of your subjects
- Planning and preparing lessons and setting learning objectives
- Managing classes, promoting good behavior and minimizing disruptions
- Using information and communication technology (ICT) effectively
- Awareness of the professional values expected of teachers, in their attitudes and behavior towards pupils and colleagues

Content

Teaching and learning in this course are organized to meet your needs, therefore this is a online course. This course has a research orientated learning method (also called problem based learning). The main focus is about how humans learn. The student meets a problem and wants to find a solution.

On the Primary (5-11 years old pupils) course you will study

- the Core and Foundation Subjects of the National British Curriculum and
- the subjects you are already teaching, and
- develop subject strength in one Foundation Subject.
- General Professional Studies will help you to develop the knowledge and skills necessary for teaching in 21st century schools.

The secondary school teacher teaches one or two national curriculum subjects to classes of pupils aged 11-16 or 11-18. The 3.5 years program trains you as a secondary teacher. It makes you accuracies the knowledge to achieve a degree and qualified teacher status.

Examination

The standards for the award of Qualified Teacher Status are outcome statements that set out what a trainee teacher must know, understand and be able to do to be awarded Qualified Teacher Status. The standards are organized in three inter-related sections:

- *Professional Values and Practice*
- *Knowledge and Understanding*
- *Teaching*

We work together with local universities or equivalent in order to examine the course depending on where you live and your ambitions.

Primary Teacher training - more details

Primary Teacher training As a primary teacher you will work with children between the ages of

five and eleven (5-11) and often teach a variety of subjects in the national curriculum. The subjects are divided into core subjects and non-core foundation subjects.

The core subjects are English, maths, science and citizenships and the non-core foundation subject are amongst others information and communication technology (ICT), history and geography. Primary teacher training are 135 week.

Year 1

Study Skills, professional Studies 1 & 2, school experiences, primary subjects, how Language Works and texts and Context's

Year 2

Professional Studies 3 & 4, primary subjects, school experiences, children's literature, image and text and arts in Education

Year 3

Professional Studies 5 & 6, school experiences, primary subjects, English: text-based project and 10 weeks exam project

Secondary Teacher training - more details

As a secondary school teacher you will teach one or two national curriculum subjects to classes of pupils aged 11-16 or 11-18.

This 157 weeks (3.5 years) program makes it possible for you to become a secondary teacher. It makes you accuracies the knowledge to achieve a degree and qualified teacher status. If you study the whole program, you will either study five or seven terms depending on if you study in one or two subjects.

This is how our secondary teacher training is designed

Term 1

Study skills, Secondary Professional Studies 1 and Secondary School-Based Work 1

Term 2, 3, 4 and 5

You study two terms for each subject, you choose one or two subjects. Your degree should be relevant to the subject you want to train to teach.

Term 6 and 7

Secondary Professional Studies 2 and 3, Secondary School-Based Work 2 and 3 and Exam work in term 7.

The course fee

Both of the courses, Primary and Secondary Teacher Training, include study periods with a number of study units. Please ask for more information about fees from your local agent or MKFC Stockholm College.
